Healthcare Trustees of New York State is pleased to announce a call for nominations for its 2019 Trustee Leadership and Advocacy Award. This award will be presented at the HTNYS Annual Trustee Conference on Saturday, September 14, at The Saratoga Hilton in Saratoga Springs.

Who qualifies

All HTNYS members are eligible to be nominated **except for trustees who currently serve on the HTNYS board of governors**. HTNYS members are any individuals currently serving on the board of a Healthcare Association of New York State member facility.

The nominee should demonstrate a profound impact in the boardroom in terms of trustee skills, time commitment and knowledge required for effective decision making. HTNYS is especially interested in nominations on behalf of trustees who are taking a lead role in positioning their organizations to meet the challenges of the evolving healthcare environment. The nominee should also demonstrate outstanding contributions in grassroots advocacy initiatives on behalf of a hospital or health system.

Entry guidelines

- Individuals must be nominated by a board chair and the chief executive officer using our [nomination form](#).
- **A letter of support** from the hospital or health system's chief executive officer and the board chair must also be submitted by e-mail to emaze@hanys.org with "2019 Trustee Award Nomination" in the e-mail subject line. - **All nominations must be submitted by 5 p.m. on June 21.**

A review panel of national governance and leadership experts will review the nominations and determine the winner.
